## BINGO

Write a short story using your vocabulary words. (Make sure to <u>underline</u> your words)	Create a short script/skit/play that uses your vocabulary words.	Make cards with your vocabulary words and play charades with a family member.	Draw a picture or pictures that incorporate/represent your vocabulary words
Play a board game. Use the directions on the back to play with a family member.	Make two sets of cards (one with the words and a second with the definitions) and play Memory.	Come up with a motion that represents each word. Describe or illustration the motion on paper.	Write a poem using your vocabulary words.
Write a song or rap using your vocabulary words.	Come up with your own activity!	Create a test with your vocabulary words You may use matching, multiple choice, or true/false.	Create a cartoon strip using all of your words in the conversations between characters.
Using a thesaurus, find an antonym and a synonym for each vocabulary word.	Write a riddle for each word and have a family member read them to try and figure them out.	Make a PowerPoint presentation with the vocabulary words, definitions, and pictures to match them.	Make cards with the word and definition. Have someone hide them around the house and read the cards aloud when you find them.
