Practice Sort & Write it:

First, sort words while reading them aloud. Then, use I-2 words to write creative sentences

Speed Sort:

Have a friend and/or parent time your sort.
Try to beat your previous time.

Word Hunt:

Find words in the book you are reading that match your spelling words. Record the sentences on a separate sheet of paper.

Open Sort:

Sort your words into your own categories and record your sort on a separate sheet of paper.

White Board Sort:

Practice writing your word sort on a whiteboard. Read each word aloud and write them down from memory.

Blind Sort:

Have a friend and/or parent read your words aloud while you sort and write your words down.

Definitions:

Use a dictionary to define at least 5 of your spelling words. Write down your definitions on a separate sheet of paper.

Consonants vs. Vowels: Write your words with red consonants and blue vowels.

Secret Code Spelling: Create a secret code

and write your words using your code.
Bonus: have a friend and/or parent try to figure our your code.
