<p>Practice Sort & Write it: First, sort words while reading them aloud. Then, use 1-2 words to write creative sentences</p>	<p>Speed Sort: Have a friend and/or parent time your sort. Try to beat your previous time.</p>	<p>Word Hunt: Find words in the book you are reading that match your spelling words. Record the sentences on a separate sheet of paper.</p>
<p>Open Sort: Sort your words into your own categories and record your sort on a separate sheet of paper.</p>	<p>White Board Sort: Practice writing your word sort on a whiteboard. Read each word aloud and write them down from memory.</p>	<p>Blind Sort: Have a friend and/or parent read your words aloud while you sort and write your words down.</p>
<p>Definitions: Use a dictionary to define at least 5 of your spelling words. Write down your definitions on a separate sheet of paper.</p>	<p>Consonants vs. Vowels: Write your words with red consonants and blue vowels.</p>	<p>Secret Code Spelling: Create a secret code and write your words using your code. Bonus: have a friend and/or parent try to figure out your code.</p>
